ACMA Investigation Update

The new Committee has been working on answering the enquiries coming from two different sections of the Australian Communications and Media Authority (ACMA).

The complaint handling section of the ACMA is ongoing, and we will let you know more about it as soon as possible. As for the licensing section of the ACMA, we are hoping that a survey of the community will be a first step in proving that we are a community-based association who truly has the interest of its Tamworth listeners at heart.

This survey is being organized with the local marketing agency called SHOUT, and will be based on previous surveys done by the Community Broadcasting Association of Australia.

The professionalism involved to do that survey will enable us to cater more appropriately for the need of our listeners, and to better the quality of our programming.

Technical Improvements

- New microphones in studios: new mikes have replaced those that used to pick up every bit of noise made in the studio: no more fish tank effect!
- Lock on Equipment Room door secured.
- The new desk (panel) has arrived and will soon be installed in Studio A: all presenters will receive training to ensure we get the most out of this beautiful piece of equipment. Brian Howard and his team of experienced broadcasters & trainers are going to be busy! Receiving the new desk was better than getting a Christmas present for some of the presenters who were grinning all around!

Judy's Cookery Corner

Cornflakes Honey Slice

1 ½ cups cornflakes
1 cup rolled oats
1 1/3 cup coconut
¾ cup castor sugar
125g butter
2 tablespoons honey

Lightly grease a 19cm by 29cm lamington pan.

Combine cornflakes, oats, coconut and sugar in a bowl. Melt butter in saucepan, add honey, and stir into dry ingredients. Spread into prepared pan. Bake into moderate oven for about 20 minutes. Stand 15 minutes before cutting.

Thank you for the Music



Born in Armidale. The first 27 years I spent in Tenterfield. While I'm not the *Tenterfield Saddler*, I am a saddler by trade. Very active in sport in Tenterfield, representing Tenterfield in cricket, tennis and basketball in inter-district sport, and also representing the district in the same sports.

Moved to Tamworth in 1960. Self employed as a saddler.

In 1961, established the Tamworth branch of the modern Country Music Association, which I was a president of, the first 6 years. During this time the Country Music Festival was established, with the Country Music awards being introduced 6 years later due to the very strong following of the very professional festival.

1972: I established my recording label (Opal records), recording over the years names like Lindsay Butler, Brian young, Stan Coster, Jimmy Little, Colin Hardy, Buddy Weston, Christine George, etc.

1986: I became a member of 2YOU, and fought for 12 months to have Country music aired on the station. Later years I was a Board member, also a security officer and in charge of general maintenance.

Also spent many evenings with Marie De Groot printing the 2YOU FM monthly newsletter. Forty odd years later, I am still a self-employed saddler, and still in the recording industry, and back at 2YOU!
